Examination Details

- Where? **On Zoom.** *Links will be sent via e-mail at the beginning of March to all of you individually. **All sessions will be recorded.***
- **Format:**
 - Oral fully, closed book.
 - No material permitted.
 - No calculator required nor permitted.
- **Questions:**
 - **Five** individual questions in first hour for each student (**Each five points**)=25.
 - **Three** group discussion questions across all students (**Each ten points**)=30.Total points: 55 from which I will evaluate your grade, based on your answers.
 - Questions range in varying levels of difficulty and complexity.

Content

- From Lecture 1 to Lecture 13.
- May include components of Assignments 1 and 2.
- May include material from examples in the textbook.
- May include exercise class material.
- May include conceptual questions.
- All questions will require deep thinking and analysis so be prepared to work hard over the three hours of the exam.
- *Remember that the aim is for you to convince me that you have understood the material taught in the course.*

Oral Examination Protocols

- You must be having good sound and camera quality.
 - A headset is recommended.
 - Please check the video and voice quality over zoom before the exam.
- You must be sitting 2 m away from the camera.
- I must be able to see your hands/arms along with the upper body.
- If you have an internet outage, you will be allowed up to 5 minutes to connect back. If not, we will need to assess the situation at that time.
- For individual questions: If the question is not for you, you should not talk at all. If you talk when you are not supposed to, you will get 0.
- For group discussions: I will initiate the discussion and ask various people to contribute, after which you are allowed to talk.

Some Tips

- If you do not understand the question, please ask me again.
- For each question, I would like to see your thinking:
 - You need to demonstrate how you think about answering the question as a process.
- Not all questions may have an answer and some may be playing tricks.
